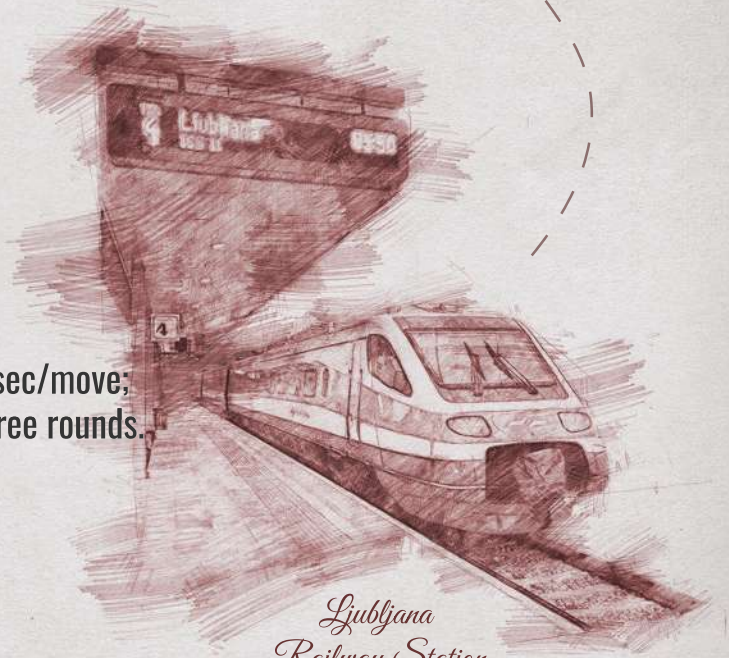
REGULATIONS

System of play:

- 9 rounds, Swiss system (Baku Accelerated);
- 75 min + 30 sec/move
and after 40 moves the addition of 15 min + 30 sec/move;
- possible 2x bye (1/2 points), except in the last three rounds.

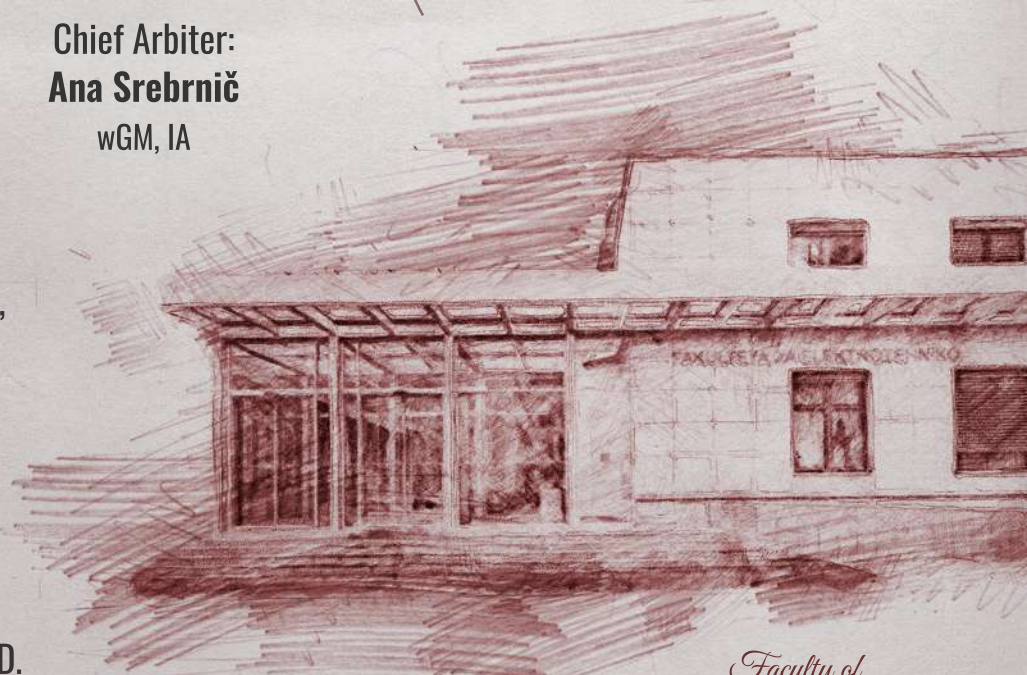

Prize fund: 13.000,00 EUR (gross)

In order to receive a prize, a player needs to submit his/her tax number, bank account number, address of the recipient and a copy of the passport. Prizes are paid out after the end of the tournament in accordance with tax legislation (for foreign players - 10.5% and for Slovenian players - 25% tax). Each player can only receive one prize.

- Player can receive only one prize. If the player does not attend the award ceremony, he/she is no longer entitled to receive the prize;
- The tournament will be rated for FIDE RATING;

Payment of the Entry fee is not possible in cash.

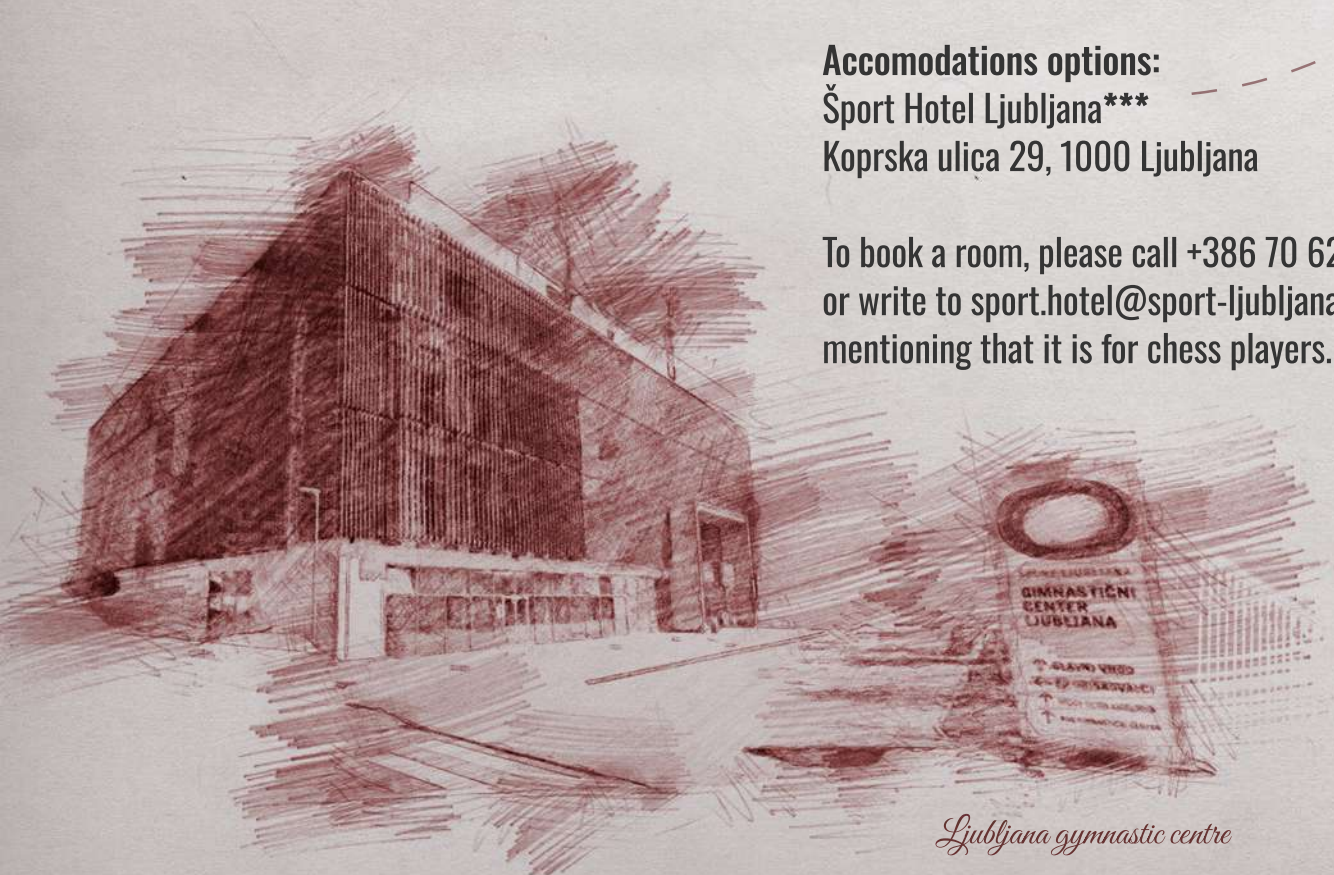
